GENERAL CLEANING

Regular cleaning can be done by simply washing the mats with warm water, soap and a stiff brush. Boat washing soap or other mild detergent, water and a hose works well. Although Aquadeck is stain resistant, certain things, such as food, wine, or grease may stain the mats if they are left for an extended period of time. It is always best to clean or rinse away any spills as soon as possible.

Work the cleaner into the stain with a stiff brush, brushing parallel to the grain texture, and rinse with a hose to finish.

STORAGE

Aquadeck is very resistant to most weather conditions and is designed to be in the elements while being used. It is, however, best to keep your Aquadeck flooring covered or stored indoors while not being used to extend its life. Aquadeck should be treated and maintained the same way you maintain carpet or other floor coverings. Excessive continuous exposure to sunlight and water can decrease the life of your mats.

HOW TO ADDRESS AN AIR BUBBLE?

While it is not common for your floor to form air bubbles under the mats, given the right conditions, it is possible. Customers should look over the product thoroughly after installation to ensure no air bubbles form from expansion. These areas can expand over time with heat and cold.

Issues with air bubbles will not be covered under Aquadeck's warranty, and the customer should remove the air bubbles themselves. To fix this issue, use a straight pin or needle to deflate the air bubble and apply pressure to glue down on the deck.

*It is best to address issues as soon as they become apparent to avoid future problems.

THINGS TO AVOID

- **Sharp objects such as knives or tools dragged across the surface.**
- **Pressure washing due to the risk of shredding, or cutting the mats.**
- **Extended contact with petroleum-based products. This can cause a stain that may not be removable.**

MATERIAL NOTE

Aquadeck foam has a memory. If you notice an indent in the mats when you remove your cover or where something with some weight has been sitting for an extended period, that mat will rebound over a short period of time back to its original shape.
